

California's General Child Care and Development (CCTR) Do you want FREE childcare?

CCTR is a program that seeks to alleviate financial burdens and enable parents to continue their employment or education while ensuring the well-being and growth of their children. The program aims to support working parents and parents pursuing education or training by providing affordable Childcare options. CCTR ensures that children have access to safe, nurturing environments that promote their healthy development and early learning. It is offered at all Children's Choice and Children's Choice Academy locations.

Who is eligible?

Eligibility for the CCTR program is based on several factors:

- **Income**: Families must meet specific income guidelines set by the California Department of Education (CDE). The income limits vary depending on the size of the family and the county in which they reside.
- **Employment or Education**: Parents or legal guardians must be working, seeking employment, or attending an eligible educational or training program.
- **Need for Child Care**: Families must have a need for Child Care services due to their employment, education, or training requirements.
